#### PURCHASE AGREEMENT

This Purchase contract is between Washington Local Schools ("Seller") whose address 19-3501-W. Lincolnshire Blvd; Toledo, Lucas County, Ohio 43606 and Auto Financing USA, LLC ("Purchaser") whose address is 5655 Secor Road, Toledo, Lucas County, OH 43623. The date that Seller or Purchaser last signs and delivers a fully executed copy of this Agreement to the other, without change, is the Effective Date of this Agreement.

SECTION 1. PURCHASE AND SALE; PROPERTY, Seller agrees to sell and convey to Purchaser, and Purchaser agrees to purchase and pay for, upon the terms and conditions contained in this Agreement, the following (the "Property):

The property commonly known as: 5720 Secor Rd, Toledo, Lucus County, Ohio 43623. Parcel # 23-56377

1.2. All buildings, structures, fixiures and improvements on the land, if any, and all other rights, privileges and appurlenances owned by Seller and in any way related to, or used in connection with, the real estate described above; and

1.3. The following items of personal property located on or used in connection with the real estate:

SECTION 2. PURCHASE PRICE. The total purchase price for the Property shall be \$150,000.00. (the "Purchase Price"), which subject to the adjustments and protation provided for in this Agreement, shall be payable as follows:

2.1. The sum of \$7,500.00 shall be paid as earnest money deposit (the "Deposit") to Louisville Title ("Title Co") upon full execution of the Agreement. The Deposit shall be held by Title Co's Trust Account without interest in accordance with the terms sot forth in this Agreement and either (a) credited to the Purchaser price at the "Closing" (as hereinafter defined); (b) released to Seller if this Agreement is terminated by Seller due to Purchaser's default pursuant to Section 10.1; or (c) returned to Purchaser if this Agreement is terminated by Purchaser pursuant to the exercise of any right of termination provided to Purchaser in this Agreement (including, but not limited to, Seller's default or the failurs of any condition). If the deposit is held by Title Co, it is understood that Title Co shall comply with all rules of the Ohio Division of Real Estate. In the event of a dispute between Seller and Purchaser regarding the disbursement of the earnest money, Title Co is required by Ohio law to maintain such funds in its trust account until Broker receives (a) written instructions signed by both parties specifying how the earnest money is to be disbursed, or (b) a final court order that specifies to whom the earnest money is to be awarded. If, within two (2) years from the date the money was deposited in Title Co's Trust Account, the parties have not provided Broker with such signed instructions or written notice that such legal action to resolve the dispute has been filed, Title Co shall return the earnest money to Purchaser with no further notice to Seller.

2.2. The balance of the Purchase Price, subject to adjustments and protation shall be paid in full at the time of Closing by a certified or cashier's check or by whe transfer of federal funds.

Inspection Contingency, From and after the Effective Date for a period of  $\frac{1}{12}$  days (the "Inspection Contingency Pariod"), Purchaser shall approve and find acceptable, in Purchaser's sole discretion, the results of any inspections of the Property that Purchaser may cause, at Purchaser's sole cost, to be performed. If any inspection obtained by Purchaser discloses any problem in the Property or in the vicinity of the Property that is unacceptable to Purchaser in its sole discretion, then Purchaser may: (i) agree with Solier to a reduction in the Purchase Price; (ii) permit Selier at Solier's sole cost to remedy the problem to Purchaser's satisfaction within a reasonable time period; or (iii) terminate this Agreement; provided, however, Selier shall not be obligated to remedy any problems reported by Purchaser. Absent Selier's actual receipt of written notice of the unacceptability of any such inspection prior to the expiration of the Inspection Contingency Period, this contingency shall be deemed waived and satisfled,

3.1.2. <u>Environmental Contingency</u>, From and after the Biffective Date for a period of <u>M</u>/<u>M</u> days (the "Environmental Contingency Period") Seller shall provide Purchaser, at Seller's sole cost or <u>Purchaser may obtain, at Purchaser's sole cost</u>, a Phase I Environmental Site Assessment of the Property (the "Phase I") prepared for the express benefit of Purchaser and Purchaser's lender by an environmental consultant acceptuble to Purchaser. The Phase I shall not be dated more than thirty (30) days prior to Seller's acceptance hereof. The Phase I shall be of sufficient scope and detail to satisfy Purchaser and Purchaser's lender that the Property is free and clear of all toxic substances, hazardous subatances, hazardous waste, underground storage tanks and petroleum products. If the Phase I discloses any problem with the Property or in the violitity of the Property that is unacceptable to Purchaser in its sole clast of remedy the problem to Purchaser's satisfaction within a reasonable time period; or (iii) permit Seller's sole cost to remedy the problem to Purchaser's satisfaction within a reasonable time period; or (iii) terminate this Agreement; provided, however, Seller shall not be obligated to remedy any problems reported by Purchaser. Absent Seller's actual receipt of written notice of the unacceptability of any such inspection prior to the expiration of the Bavironmental Contingency Period, this contingency shall be deemed waived and satisfied,

3.1.3. Verification of Zoning. From and after the Effective Date for a period of  $W_{-}/M_{-}$  days (the "Zoning Verification Contingency Period"), Purchaser shall have determined that the zoning classification of the Property permits, as of right, the use of the Property for its current use or any use intended by Purchaser. If the zoning classification of the Property does not permit the use of the Property for its current use or Purchaser's intended use, then this Agreement shall automatically terminate absent Seller's receipt of written notice from Purchaser of Purchaser's intend to waive the Zoning Verification Contingency Period no later than five (5) days from the expiration of the Zoning Verification Contingency Period.

3.1.4. 3.1.5. Leases. Within five (5) days of the Effective Date, Salle Abal deliver complete copies of all leases affecting the Property (the "Leases") to Purchaser. Purchaser shall have the days after receipt of the Leases to review, approve and find acceptable the terms of the Leases in its sole discretion (the"Lease Review Contingency Period"). 3.1.7. Financing. From and after the Effective Date for a period of \_ lays (the "Finanoing Contingency" Period"), Purchaser shall have obtained a commitment for a morigage loan from a lending institution for a purchase money mortgage of at least \$100,000.00, with interest at current provailing market rates, and on other terms and conditions acceptable to Purchaser. Purchaser shall apply for such mortgage loan within ten (10) days of acceptance and pursue such mortgage loan in good faith. Absent Seller's actual receipt of written notice of Purchaser's inability to secure such commitment for a mortgage loan prior to the expiration of the Financing Contingency Period, this contingency shall be deemed waived and satisfied,

3.1.8. Seller's Information. Within five (5) business days after the Effective Date, Seller shall provide to Purchaser copies of the following items relating to the Property if the same are in Seiler's possession or in the possession of . any agents or former agents of Seller (the "Seller Information"); (a) a copy of Seller's latest issued owner's policy and commitment of title insurance for the Property; (b) surveys of the Property; (c) plans and specifications for the buildings, structures and other improvements located on the Property; and (d) all environmental reports and all engineering reports. Purchaser shall have \_\_\_\_\_\_ days after receipt of the Seller Information to review, approve and find acceptable the Seller Information in its sole disorction (the " Seller Information Contingency Period"). Absent Seller's actual receipt of written notice of the unacceptubility of the terms of the Seller Information prior to the expiration of the Seller Information Contingency Period, this contingency with be deemed waived and satisfied.

3.1.9. Tenant Approval. Puphase Agreement is subject to satisfactory approval of end user tenant (s) and lease agreement with Purchaser.

3.2. Entry. Immediately upon the execution of this Agreement and continuing through the date of Closing, Seller shall make the Property available for inspection by Purchaser and Purchaser's agents, employees and contractors. Inspections shall be conducted during normal business hours. Seller shall be given advance notice of the times when inspectors will be present on the Property, and the opportunity to have a representative present during the inspections, Purchaser hereby indemnifies Seller and holds harmless Seller from all costs, plaims, and/or damages arising out of or in connection with such access. All information and/or reports obtained by Purchaser concerning the Property shall be kept confidential and shall not be disclosed to third parties (other than Purchaser's attorneys, lenders and consultants) without Seller's consent. The provisions of this Section 3,2 shall survive the termination of this Agreement,

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3.3. <u>"As Is" Sale</u>. Purchaser represents that upon completion of its inspections of the Property as contemplated under this Section 3, Purchaser will have fully inspected the Property, will have made all investigations as it deems necessary or appropriate and will be relying solely upon its inspection and investigation of the Property for all purposes whatsoever, including, but not limited to the determination of the condition of the structures, improvements, soils, subsurface, drainage, surface and groundwater quality, and all other physical characteristics; availability and adequacy of utilities; compliance with governmental laws and obstacter and autability of the Property. In addition, Purchaser acknowledges that the Property is purchased and will be conveyed "as is" with all faults and defects, whether patent or latent, as of the date of closing. There have been no representations, warrantles, guarantees, statements or information, express or implied, pertaining to the Property, its condition, or any other matters whatsoever, made to or furnished to Purchaser by Selier, any employee or agent of Selier, Broker, as defined herein, or any employee or agent of Broker, except as specifically set forth in this Agreement.

3.4. <u>Due Diligence Materials</u>. Within 15 days of the Effective Date, the Setter shall provide to Purchaser all documents in its possession relevant to the Contingency Provisions contained herein. These documents shall include but not be limited to any environmental documents, any previous surveys or title work.

#### SECTION 4. TITLE AND SURVEY.

Title. Within Ten (10) days after the Effective Date Seller shall furnish Furchaser a Commitment for a Title 4.1. Insurance Policy along with legible copies of all exception documents (the "Commitment"). The Commitment shall be propaged and issued by Louisville Title Co. Soller shall pay for the costs of the titlo search/examination as well as the premlum cost of the Owner's Policy of Title Insurance based upon the Purchase Price. All other title insurance costs and expenses will be paid by the Purchaser. The Commitment shall be continued to the date of Closing, shall bear a stated liability equal to the Purchase Price of the Property, and shall show record title to be marketable in the name of Soller, free and clear from material defects, liens and encumbrances, subject only to the following "Permitted Exceptions": (a) All logal highways; (b) Zoning, building and other laws, ordinances, codes and regulations; (c) Matters disclosed by the Survey pursuant to Section 4.2; (d) Easements, rights-of-way, conditions, covenants and restrictions acceptable to Purchaser, in Purchaser's reasonable discretion; and (e) Real estate taxes and assessments that are a lien upon the Property, but not yet due and payable. Any mortgage or other monetary liens on the Property ("Encumbrancos") are to be discharged and paid by Soller at the time of Closing. At the Closing, and as a condition to Purchaser's obligations under this Agreement, the Title Company shall deliver to Purchaser a marked up policy of title insurance in accordance with the Commitment (the "Title Policy"), Soller shall provide a reasonable and customary affidavit as may be required by the Title Company to delete the "standard" or "general" exceptions from the Title Policy.

4.2. <u>Defects and Cure</u>. If the Commitment discloses matters other than the Permitted Exceptions and Encumbrances, Purchaser shall notify Seller of Purchaser's disapproval of any such matters contained in the Commitment ("Objections") no later than five (5) days from Purchaser's receipt of the Commitment ("Title Review Period"), Except for Encumbrances, Purchaser's failure to notify seller of disapproval of any matter before the expiration of the Title Review Period shall be deemed approval of that matter. If Purchaser notifies Seller of the Objections in the manner set forth above, Seller may, but shall not be obligated to, proceed to cure or remove such objections at or prior to the Closing (except that Seller shall be obligated to remove any Encumbrances). If Seller falls to cure the Objections, Purchaser shall either (a) waive the Objections, in which case such Objections shall become Permitted Exceptions, or (b) terminate this Agreement, in which case the Deposit shall be returned to Purchaser and the parties shall be released from all further obligations under this Agreement

Survey, Within Aff days of the Effective Date, Purchaser shall obtain seller shall provide at its expense, a boundary survey an ALTA survey and a legal description of the Property prepared by a registered iand surveyor acceptable to Purchaser (the "Survey"). The legal description of the Property determined by the Survey shall be used in Seller's deed. If the Property is not currently established as a separate parcel of real estate, Seller shall, prior to Closing, apply for and obtain all necessary tot split and/or subdivision approvals necessary for the conveyance of the Property as a separate parcel of real estate. If the Survey shows any encroachments or that the Property violated any

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SECTION 5. REPRESENTATIONS, WARRANTIES AND COVENANTS OF SELLER. Solier represents, warrants and covenants to Purchaser as to the following matters, and shall be deemed to remake all the following representations, warranties and covenants as of the date of Closing:

5.1. The execution and delivery of this Agreement by Seller, the execution and delivery of every other document and instrument delivered pursuant to this Agreement by Seller, and the consummation of the transactions contemplated by this Agreement, have been duly authorized and validity executed and delivered by Seller and will not (a) constitute or result in the breach of or default under any oral or written agreement to which Seller is a party or which affect the Property in any material way; (b) constitute or result in a violation of any order, decree or injunction with respect to which Seller and/or the Property is bound; and/or (c) violate any provision of any municipal, state or federal law, statutory or otherwise, to which Seller or the Property may be subject.

5.2. To Seller's knowledge, no toxic, hazardous, explosive or otherwise dangerous materials, substances, pollutanta, or wastes, as those terms are used in the Clean Air Aot, the Clean Water Aot, Resource Conservation and Recovery Act of 1976, the Hazardous Materials Transportation Aot, the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act of 1980 ("CERCLA"), the Emergency Planning and Community Right-to-Know Act or in any other federal, state or total law environmental law (collectively "Environmental Laws"), petroleum products, polychiorinated biphenyis, or mold in quantities for which remediation is appropriate, have been or are stored, treated, disposed of, managed, generated, manufactured, produced, released, emitted or discharged on, in or under the Property, in violation of any Environmental Law.

5.3. To Sellers knowledge, there is no pending or threatened Hilgation arbitration, administrative action or examination, claim or demand relating to the Property.

5.4. Selfer has no knowledge of any pending or contemplated eminent domain, condemnation, or other governmental or quasi-governmental taking of any part or all of the Property.

5.5. To Seller's knowledge, except as shown in the Commitment, there are no public improvements that have been ordered to be made and/or that have not been previously assessed, and, to Seller's knowledge, there are no special, general or other claims outstanding or available to any party in connection with the ownership, operation, repair or maintenance or leasing of the Property,

5,6. The representations of Seller set forth in this Agreement shall survive the Closing.

SECTION 6. CLOSING AND TRANSFER OF TITLE.

Saller's Documents, At Cloving, Seller shall execute and/or deliver to Purchasor the following: 6.2.1. A general warranty deed to the Property conveying tills to the Property to Purchaser in accordance with Section 4, subject, however, to the Permitted Exceptions.

6.2.2. An owner's affidavit as to mechanics' liens, persons in possession of the Property, unrecorded agreements, and such other matters required by the Title Company as a condition to its deletion of /

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the standard exceptions relating to such matters from the Title Policy, in reasonable and customary form.

6.2.3. An owner's affidavit, in form and substance reasonable satisfactory to Purchaser, signed under panalty of perjury and containing Seller's U.S. taxpayer identification number, to the effect that Seller is not a foreign person within the meaning of Section 1445(f) of the Internal Revenue Code.

- 6.2.4. Evidence of the power and authority of Seller, through the officer(s) acting on behalf of Seller, to enter into and perform this Agreement and the transactions contemplated by this Agreement.
- 6.2.5. Such other documents or instruments as Purchaser or the Title Company may reasonably request in order to consummate this transaction, including, but not limited to, a closing statement.

- Purchaser's Documents. At closing, Purchaser shall execute and/or deliver to Seller the following
- 6.3.1. Evidence of the power and authority of Purchaser, through the officer(s) acting on behalf of Purchaser, to enter into and perform this Agreement and the transactions contemplated by this Agreement; and;
- 6.3.2. Such documents and instruments as Seller or the Title Company may reasonably request in order to consummate this transaction, including, but not limited to, a closing statement.

SECTION 7. POSSESSION, Seller shall deliver possession of the Property to Purchaser at Closing subject to the rights of any tenants set forth in the Leases,

SECTION 8. PRORATIONS AND EXPENSES.

8.1. <u>Proration of Real Estate Taxes and Assessments</u>. Seller shall pay all real estate taxes and assessments with respect to the Property that become due and payable prior to the Closing. If the property is located in Lucas County, real estate taxes and assessments, both general and special, shall be pro-rated in accordance with the "due and payable method according to Lucas County Custom. If the property is located-outside Lucas County, real-estate taxes and assessments, both general and special, shall be pro-rated in accordance with the "due and payable method according to Lucas County Custom. If the property is located-outside Lucas County, real-estate taxes and assessments, both general and epsciel, shall be pro-rated in accordance with due and payable method or lien-method. If no method is specified, the proration shall be in accordance with the due and payable method. In the event that the taxes and assessments for the year of Closing are not yet determined, the proration shall be based upon the taxes and assessments paid in the prior year. The proration shall be final. If the Property or any part of the Property has been listed on the agricultural land list, Seller will pay to Purchase or credit against the Purchase Price, at Closing, the estimated amount of the recoupment of real estate taxes in connection with the conversion of the Property form agricultural land to a non-agricultural use.

8.2. <u>Other Expenses.</u> Seller shall pay (a) any transfer tax, conveyance fee or similar charge in connection with the sale of the Property, and (b) one-half of any escrow and closing fees of the Title Company. Purchaser shall pay (c) recording charges relating to Seller's deed, and (d) one-half of any escrow and closing fees of the Title Company.

SECTION 9. CONDEMNATION. In the ovent that, prior to the Closing, Seller received a written notice from any governmental or quasi-governmental authority with powers of eminent domain to the effect that a condemnation as to any portion or all of the Property is pending or contemplated, Seller shall notify Purchaser promptly after receipt of the notice. If the proposed condemnation affects a material portion of the Property, in Purchaser's judgment, Purchaser may, within ten (10) days after receipt of notice of the event, terminate this Agreement, in which event the Deposit shall be returned to the Purchaser, and neither party shall have any further rights or obligations under this agreement. In the event that Purchaser shall not elect to terminate this Agreement, or if the condemnation does not affect a material portion of the Property as/

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described above, then this Agreement shall remain in full force and effect, and Seller shall be entitled to all monies received or collected prior to the Closing by reason of the condemnation, Purchaser has the right to approve the amount of any negotiated condomnation award. In that event, this transaction shall close in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Agreement except that there will be an abatement of the Purchase Price equal to the amount of the gross proceeds received by Seller, If, however, Seller has not received any proceeds by reason of such condemnation prior to the Closing and Purchaser has not exercised its right to terminate Purchaser's obligations under this Agreement, then the Closing shall take place without abatement of the Purchase Price, and Seller shall assign and transfer to Purchaser at Closing, by written instrument reasonably satisfactory to the parties, all of Seller's right, title and interest in any condemnation awards.

#### SECTION 10. DEFAULT.

10.1. <u>Purchaser's Default</u>. If Seller is ready, willing and able to convey the Property in accordance with this Agreement, and Purchaser is obligated under the terms of this Agreement to consummate the transaction but fails to do so, the parties agree that Seller shall be entitled to receive and retain the Deposit as liquidated damages in the event of Purchaser's default. Seller's right to the Deposit shall constitute a waiver by Seller of all other rights and remedies against Purchaser except for those rights and/or obligations that are expressly stated to survive the termination of this Agreement.

10.2. <u>Selier's Default</u>. In the event of a successful specific performance action by Purchaser, the full Purchase Price shall be paid to Seller at the time of Closing.

SECTION 1.1. BROKER, Each party represents and warrants to the other that they have dealt with no agent or broker who has in any way participated in the sale of the Property except for Broker, whose fee shall be paid by the Seller. #### SECTION 14. MISCELLANEOUS,

14.1. <u>Construction of Terms and Headings</u>. Words used in this Agreement shall be held and construed to include the masculine or feminine gender and the singular or plural as the context requires. The captions or headings in this Agreement are for convenience only and are not intended to define, limit or prescribes the scope or effect of any part or provision of this Agreement.

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14.2. <u>Construction</u>. No provisions of this Agreement shall be construed by any court or other judicial authority against any part by reason of that party's being deemed to have drafted or structured the provisions,

14.3. <u>Entire Agreement</u>. This Agreement constitutes the entire contract between the parties and supersedes all prior understandings, if any, there being no other oral or written promises, conditions, representations, understandings or terms of any, kind as conditions or inducements to the execution of the Agreement and none have been relied upon by either party. Any subsequent conditions, representations, warranties or agreements shall not be valid and binding upon the parties unless in writing and signed by both parties.

14.4. <u>Recording</u>, The parties agree that this Agreement shall not be recorded.

[4.5. <u>Counterparts</u>. This Agreement may be executed by the partles in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of such counterparts taken together shall constitute one and the same Agreement.

### **Executive Summary**

There are two separate items on this recommendation.

### 100 Replacement Desktop Computers

With the migration towards Chromebooks there has been a decreased need for traditional desktop computers. We have been able to reduce our desktop computer inventory from around 5,500 PCs to about 2,900 while going from 0 Chromebooks to almost 8,000 Chromebooks.

• We are currently adding the recently purchased 1,600 Chromebooks and we will be disposing an equal number of end-of-life units over the next few months.

Even with this migration away from desktop PCs there is still a need for these units as teacher and office computers. To this end we need to replace 100 desktop PCs.

### Motorized Wall Mount for interactive Displays

The traditional interactive white board (SMART Board) and mounted projector have been phased out of the market. The current technology is an interactive display panel. Think of a 75" touch screen TV. With the new spaces for Student Services we are taking our first steps into this realm. These displays typically weigh more than 100 lbs. As such a typical wall mount does not offer the support needed. Based upon discussions with other districts that have installed these display units we have opted for a wall mount that actually uses a



pedestal to carry the weight to the floor while attaching to the wall to keep the unit vertical. In addition, these mounts are motorized. Once installed, the bottom of the display panel will be able to be adjusted from about 25" from the floor to about 45" from the floor.

**RE:** District-Wide Furniture Order

On May 31, 2019, a district-wide memo was sent to all principals and/or administrators to allow requests to be made for furniture based on need due to the number of inquiries received to replace damaged furniture and/or to add furniture to classrooms. Initially, we had hoped to place this request on the June 26<sup>th</sup> agenda, however due to the specificity of some of the items, as well as obtaining the best-pricing available, this delayed receiving quotes in their entirety.

Invitations to quote were sent via e-mail to Claire David, Schools Specialty and School Outfitters. Each vendor has been utilized in the past to purchase furniture, providing exemplary customer service and addressing any and all of our requests. Per policy 6320, purchases over \$10,000 require multiple quotes be obtained and purchases greater than \$25,000 require Board approval. Based off the quotes we received before making necessary edits we were able to determine that requests for teacher chairs and desks could be fulfilled at which time we placed the order. The total for teacher chairs and desks were \$15,881.00.

Therefore, of the three quotes provided, only two vendors will be recommended to complete this purchase; Claire David and School Specialty. Please note, the quote for School Specialty was not finalized until July 18<sup>th</sup>, as we were waiting for an installation update. School Specialty regretted to inform us that if we chose them to install the furniture, it would delay delivery until late October as this is a peak time to order furniture. As School Specialty is providing the bulk of the order, we opted not to exercise this option because it would disrupt classes. Further, as we have not placed an order of this size since 2015, it is our hope to possibly begin requesting smaller orders throughout the year, on an as need basis, for various items.

I recommend to the Board of Education the purchase for district furniture be awarded to School Specialty in the amount of \$54,009.28 at the August 7, 2019 meeting of the Board of Education. We will also be placing an additional order with Claire David in the amount of \$11,118.50 for some of the special order items mentioned, however this will not require Board approval as it is under \$25,000. The combined total for both vendors to complete the order is \$65,127.78

## AUTHORIZING CONTRACT FOR PURCHASE OF STOCK SCHOOL BUSES FROM RUSH TRUCK CENTER OF OHIO, INC.

WHEREAS, the District is a member of The Ohio Schools Council (OSC), a regional council of governments created under Chapter 167 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, procurements made by the OSC on behalf of its members under a contract entered into under R.C. 167.081 are exempt from any competitive selection or bidding requirements otherwise required by law; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to R.C. 167.081, on April 11, 2019, the OSC received bids for school buses on behalf of its members, and the Board has learned that Rush Truck Center of Ohio, Inc., submitted the lowest responsible bid for school buses as part of that solicitation by the OSC; and

WHEREAS, on July 17, 2019, in accordance with its bid submitted in response to the OSC, Rush Truck Center of Ohio, Inc., provided the District with a price quotation for a total of one (1) model year 2020, 77/78passenger conventional style bus at a price of \$80,877.00; one (1) model year 2020, 77/78-passenger conventional cargo style bus at a price of \$84,704.00; and one (1) model year 2020, 72 passenger lift with three wheel chair positions school bus at a price of \$86,502.00 for a grand total of \$252,083.00; and

WHEREAS, the Board believes it is in its best interest to purchase a total of three (3) model year 2020, two (2) - 78-passenger conventional and conventional cargo buses and one (1) - 72 passenger conventional lift style bus at OSC bid pricing of \$252,083.00; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Washington Local School District Board of Education as follows:

1. The Board authorizes a contract with Rush Truck Center of Ohio, Inc., for the purchase of three (3) model year 2020, 72 and 78-passenger conventional style buses at the price set by the competitive bidding process undertaken by OSC on its member's behalf in an amount not to exceed \$252,083.00.

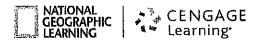
