Enclosed please find a copy of a recommendation from Craig Stough recommending the contractors for the 2013 facility improvements. We have also included the bid tabulations.

We are very excited that the bids are \$100,000 under the estimates. The work this summer will include clock systems at CTC and Washington Junior High. It will also include painting the exterior metal panels at the CTC. Other work will include remodeling the basement at Washington Junior High to include lighting, painting, carpeting, and tile in one area.

We recommend that contracts be awarded to Van Tassel Construction, Corp. for general construction in the amount of \$63,000.00. We also recommend that the electrical portion of the project be awarded to Lake Erie Technologies, Inc. in the amount of \$62,069.00.
