- 16. **REVIEW NEGOTIATIONS OR BARGAINING SESSIONS** with public employees concerning their compensation or other terms and conditions of employment.
- 17. CONSIDER MATTERS REQUIRED TO BE KEPT CONFIDENTIAL by federal law or regulations or state statutes.
