Board of Education Meeting September 7, 2019 Work Session

<u>Levy Information – Issue 7</u>

Dr. Anstadt announced that Washington Local Schools was assigned, Issue 7 by the Board of Elections, for the November ballot. Further, she provided that meetings will continue with TAWLS and OAPSE and additional groups, regarding the information that will be disseminated for the levy. Committees are continuing to form as well as the first training for door-to-door canvassing of neighborhoods and to provide additional guidance on how to have a successful campaign.

Toledo Clinic

Safe Routes Initiative

Dr. Anstadt realizes the importance and need for our students to have safe routes to school. Through the "Safe Routes Initiative," Washington Local Schools has adopted the implementation of this program. It is not just Washington Local School members that understand the need and importance for sidewalks, it is community leaders that also realize this need. Group meetings are being held monthly by city leaders to create a School Travel Plan. The Board of Education would like high priority areas within our district to have more of a push to move quicker as these areas hold potential risks and dangers for our students.
