## Syllabus

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### **Course Description:**

In this class students will learn to create Windows applications using the Microsoft Visual Basic .NET programming language. Along with learning a new language students will get a chance to practice logic and reasoning to solve problems within created programs.

The object of this class is not to create programmers, but to show students how software is developed and give students a basic understanding of the programming process.

### **Text:**

The class will utilize the Microsoft Developers Network ([www.msdn.com](http://www.msdn.com)) as well as other material provided by the instructor.

### **Course Topics**

- Demonstrate the proper use of the various controls included with VB
- Create programs using VB
- Organize files related to a project
- Create and modify forms
- Arrange the tab order of controls on a form
- Modify the properties of objects in the properties window
- Create and use message boxes, dialog boxes, menus
