WHITMER HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT PARKING CONTRACT 2018-19

DRIVING/PARKING

The following are the guidelines that all student drivers are required to follow. All provisions are enforced.

A copy of the following documents are needed to obtain a parking permit:

- Student Parking Contract
- Current State of Ohio Certificate of Registration
- Student's driver's license
- Current Proof of insurance
- Cost-\$10.00 per year

PARKING REGULATIONS

All vehicles parked on school grounds must be registered with the ARC. All registered vehicles must display the current permit on the rear-view mirror/front window only. Parking privileges may be revoked if the permit is not displayed correctly or if the vehicle is parked in the teachers section or any other restricted area. Parking regulations are enforced. It is considered a privilege to park on school grounds. Suspension of parking privileges, revocations of permits, towing of vehicles, and/or other disciplinary action (after school detention, Tuesday School, IRP, out of school suspension and exclusion from extracurricular activities) may occur for parking violations. Parking is strictly limited to the student parking lots on Whitmer Drive across from Washington and Jefferson Junior Highs. Students are not permitted to park in the spaces on Clegg Dr., Edgar St., the parking lot between the field house and the football field, by the Annex, behind Washington Junior High or the CTC parking lot.

- 1. Parking is by permit only. Parking permits must be displayed during regular school hours.
- 2. All student drivers must be licensed and covered by insurance. The school is NOT responsible for the vehicle or its contents.
- 3. Vehicles will be appropriately parked on arrival; one vehicle per space. Pull-in parking only will be permitted. Back-in-parking constitutes a violation for improper parking. Parking lot speed shall not exceed 10 miles per hour. Reckless and/or irresponsible operation is cause for revocation of parking privileges (irresponsible operation includes, but is not limited to, stop sign violations, failure to yield in crosswalks, and speeding). Students who park on campus after privileges have been revoked will receive additional disciplinary consequences. A student shall not intentionally, nor recklessly, operate a motor vehicle so as to endanger the safety, health and/or welfare of others on school property.
- 4. All regulations of the student handbook apply to the parking lot, including tobacco violations. The administration reserves the right to revoke parking privileges for any violation(s) of the Student Handbook. Students are not to loiter in the parking area nor are they to sit in their vehicles while parked on school grounds. **Student vehicles are subject to search**.
- 5. Falsifying a contract, misrepresenting a permit as lost or stolen, or displaying a permit not registered to you are causes for revocation of a parking permit and additional disciplinary consequences.
- 6. If a student changes vehicles at any point during the school year, the issued permit can be transferred to the "new" vehicle when the registration and proof of insurance are brought into the Discipline Center. An assistant principal can void this provision if extenuating circumstances exist.
