Visual and Performing Arts Nomination Component

A nomination triggers the screening and identification process. A student may nominate him or herself, or be nominated by an educator, parent, or peer. Please note that a nomination is required to start the process.

After a student is nominated, the district will obtain permission from the student's parents to screen the student before beginning the behavioral checklist and performance evaluation. If a student is nominated by his or her parent, permission for the school district to screen/assess the student in this area is implied. A separate permission form is not required when the parent signs the nomination form.
