- 3. Person addressing the Board should limit his/her remarks to three minutes unless the presentation is of an unusual nature.
- 4. Questions pertaining to the school operation should be directed to the administration at a time other than during Community Comment.
- 5. Person addressing the Board should not engage in remarks that could be interpreted as libelous or inflammatory to a particular individual.
- The Board of Education will attempt to complete the item of Community Comment within thirty minutes.

2. Resolution for Suder Avenue Easement

The Treasurer recommends that the Board of Education approve the resolution for the Suder Avenue Easement as presented:

RESOLUTION

The Washington Local Schools Board of Education, fka The Board of Education of Washington Township, the Grantors, in consideration of One and No/100 Dollars (\$1.00), and other good and valuable considerations, to them paid by the Board of Lucas County, Ohio Commissioners, the Grantee, does hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and release to the said Grantee, its successors and assigns forever, an easement for the construction and maintenance of a sidewalk in over and through the following described real property:

Suder Avenue Easement Parcel 1

See attached Exhibit "A"

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD said easement rights with all the rights, privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging to the Grantee, its successors and assigns forever.

The Grantor, for themselves, their successors and assigns, retain the right to use the attached described property for any and all purposes, provided that such use does not interfere with nor impair the exercise of the rights herein granted.

The Grantor claims title by instrument recorded in Volume. 1486, Pg. 504 of Deeds, Lucas County, Ohio, Records.

The Grantor hereby covenants that they are the true and lawful owners of said premises and are well seized of the same, and have good right and full power to bargain, sell and convey the same in the manner aforesaid.

EXHIBIT "A" Legal Description

Suder Avenue at East Harbor Avenue Parcel 1-SH

Being part of the Original Lot 1 of Section eight (8), Town nine (9) South, Range eight (8) East in Washington Township, Lucas County, Ohio, and being bounded and described as follows:

COMMENCING at a 1" iron bar found in a monument box at the intersection of the centerline of Suder Avenue with the centerline of East Harbor Avenue, being station 100+00.00 on the Suder Avenue baseline and station 10+00.00 on the East Harbor Avenue baseline;

THENCE, North 16°41'11" East, along the centerline of Suder Avenue, a distance of 25.00 feet to a point at station 100+25.00;

THENCE, at right angles to the last line, South 73°18'49" East a distance of 40.00 feet to the intersection with the existing easterly right-of-way line of Suder Avenue and the existing northerly right-of-way of East Harbor Avenue, and being marked with an Iron Bar set at a point 40.00 feet right of station 100+25.00, and being the POINT OF BEGINNING;

THENCE, North 16°41'11" East, along the existing right-of-way line of Suder Avenue, a distance of 43.00 feet to an Iron Bar set at a point 40.00 feet right of station 100+68.00:

THENCE, South 03°08'09" East a distance of 45.71 feet to an Iron Bar set at the intersection with the existing northerly right-of-way line of East Harbor Avenue at a point 55.50 right of station 100+25.00 of the Suder Avenue baseline and also being 25.00 feet left of station 10+55.50 of the East Harbor Avenue baseline;

THENCE, North 73°18'47" West, along the northerly line of East Harbor Avenue, a distance of 15.50 feet, back to the POINT OF BEGINNING;



- 17. **CONSIDER MATTERS REQUIRED TO BE KEPT CONFIDENTIAL** by federal law or regulations or state statutes.
- 18. **DISCUSS DETAILS RELATIVE TO THE SECURITY ARRANGEMENTS** and emergency response protocols for the Board of Education.
